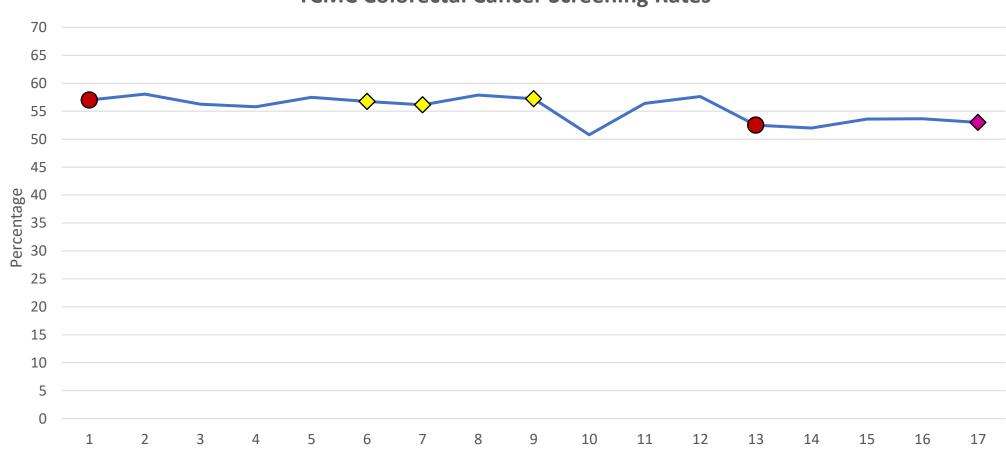

# **Not Making Progress**

Screening rates were stagnant

Follow up issues identified

Pursued case study



### **Case Study**

These sample of patients are taken from April 1, 2021, to April 30, 2022. They are taken from a list of patients who have been seen in our clinic and remain overdue at the time of the case study.

The goal of this case study is to determine why we have such a large number of patients overdue and how to improve our rate of screening.

### Results

Median age: 60.4

50% males overdue

50% females overdue

 53% of patients overdue consistently saw the listed PCP in the previous 3 years  33% of patients had received preventive care either once or routinely since 2018

 22% of patients had a preventive visit before 2018

 47% of patients overdue for CRC were overdue for their rescreening!

# What We Learned



 Health maintenance/care gaps were not being updated

 We were not using our EHR to extract the MOST accurate data

 We were giving refills on prescription medications without seeing patients yearly

# What We Did



Utilized EHR to pull accurate patient list

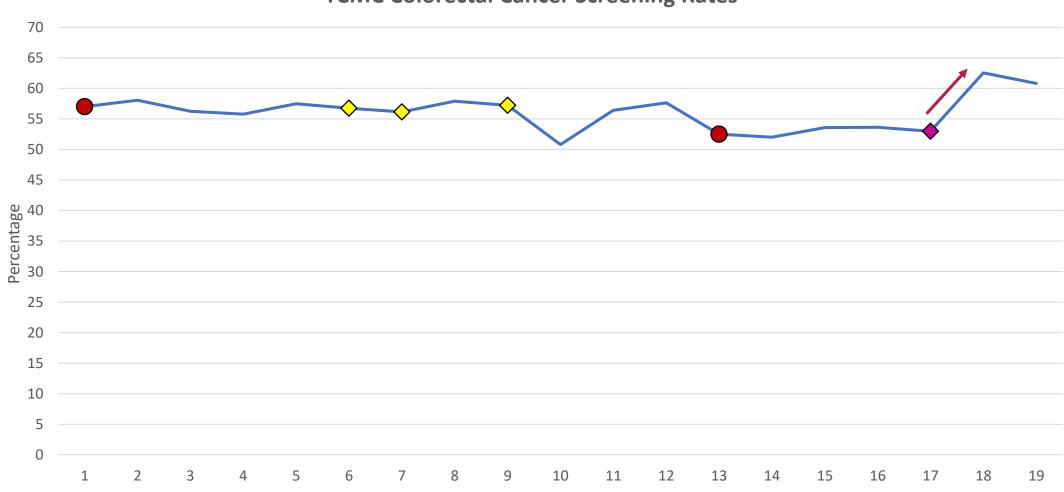
Updated overdue CRC patient charts

 Educate providers on prescribing practices

Decided on universal follow up guidelines

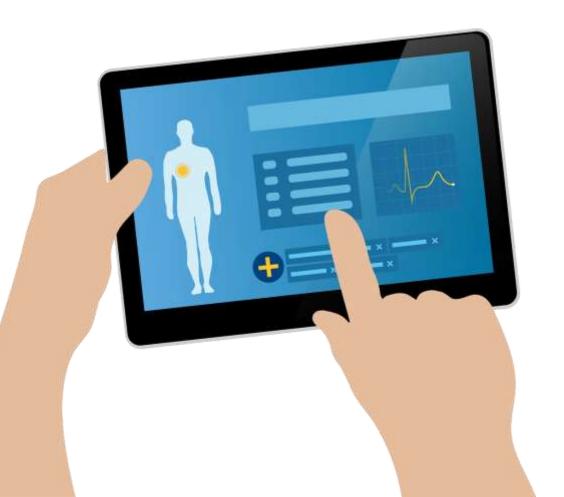
